All reports were accepted. The Provost's Office will submit the necessary documentation to the Coordinating Board.

2. Tuition and Fee Changes

Set against the backdrop of an 8.3 percent increase to the Consumer Price Index, several changes to tuition and fees were approved.

In order to simplify student billing and increase the university's flexibility to adapt to changes in student needs, the Institutional Services Fee was created and replaces seven separate existing mandatory fees (i.e. Student Publications, Computer Service, Library, ID Card, Student Success, Environmental, and International Education). This new fee is being set for undergraduate students at \$48.72/SCH and graduate students at \$72.50/SCH.

The College of Health Professions was approved to charge a differential tuition of \$20.00/SCH to match current differential tuition rates in the College of Science and Engineering and the McCoy College of Business.

The total change in the cost of tuition and fees for undergraduate students taking 15 semester hours, not inclusive of differential tuition, is \$177.70 per semester.

The total change in the cost of tuition and fees for graduate students taking 9 semester credit hours, not inclusive of differential tuition, is \$376.84 per semester.

Mr. Algoe will notify Ms. Valarie Van Vlack to post the new tuition and fee amounts to the university website.

3. FY 2023 Operating Budget Adjustments

4. Addition to 2023 – 2028 Capital Improvements Program

The addition was approved. Mr. Algoe will notify Mr. Gordon Bohmfalk to work with TSUS to finalize the addition of the James Street Housing project, Commons Hall Moisture and Structural Repairs, and the JCK Lobby Reconfiguration and Parking project to the CIP.

5. Purchase Agreement with Hopkins Square, LLC

The purchase was approved. Mr. Algoe will instruct Ms. Cristine Black to proceed with the purchase of the property.

6. Conferring of Regents' Professor Award – Jason Kwak

The President's Office will pay for the reception. The awardee will be invited by President Damphousse to sit on the stage and be honored at the awardee's commencement ceremony.
