Construction - Fall 2015 – Fall 2018

Bridge is open to traffic. Remaining items include landscaping and barrier/retaining wall paint prior to final lift of asphalt.

N LBJ and Oakridge Utility Improvements

Replace utilities on N.LBJ from Holland to Craddock and on Oakridge from N.LBJ to the east end of Oakridge. Estimated construction August 15th, 2016 – Summer 2018

<u>Design</u>

LBJ Striping - Complete.

Transportation Master Plan – Draft report was submitted in January 2017. The City has provided comments to HDR and the consultant is making revisions to the report. TMP open house was organized on October 18, 2017, for general public to provide comments. TMP report was finalized in March 2018 with <u>possible adoption</u> in May 2018.

Mill Street - Design & construction of pavement & drainage improvements along Mill Street from the intersection of Uhland Road and Mill Street to approx. 1500' north. 100% design received from the design engineer. Utilities relocation work is currently underway. <u>Construction is scheduled to begin in late summer of 2018</u>

CM Allen Reconstruction – Project is in Bid Phase. Overhead utility relocations to below grade are ongoing. Bidding will take place in April of 2018 and <u>construction should begin in mid Summer 2018</u>.

Hopkins Street Improvements: Bishop to Moore – Design is in progress. Project includes the reconstruction of the road and utilities. Drainage improvements will include downstream infrastructure and an outfall to Purgatory Creek. <u>Construction will begin in late 2018.</u>

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Sessom/Academy Drainage & Intersection Improvements – The project is currently in design process. 60% design is currently underway. Design phase is expected to be completed by May 2019 and <u>construction phase is expected to start in September 2019.</u>

Drainage Master Plan –Master Plan posted to City website for 30 days prior to City Council acceptance scheduled for May 1, 2018.

Sessom Waterline Repair – design underway to repair/replace broken water main along Sessom Dr. near Salt Grass restaurant. 90% design in progress. <u>Construction expected late 2018</u>.
