Jefferson Davis Hwy. marker update (David Bissett, Asst. Real Estate Director for Texas State)

- Texas Chapter of United Daughters of the Confederacy voted unanimously to support marker relocation
- Alternate site has been identified and land has been donated
- Because the marker is on TXDOT right-of-way, university funds cannot be used to move it
- Estimates on cost of moving the marker are being gathered and funding sources investigated

Council of Academic Deans June 21 meeting report (Senator White)

- Staff Performance, Success Factors
 - -Staff Performance evaluations transitioning to Success Factors in 2016-17
 - -Each dean to set out goals aligned with university goals that will filter down from university level to college level and, finally, to department level
- Merit raises
 - -Have been internally funded by increases in enrollment and tuition
 - -PPS7.10 being revised to remove references to "performance" raises

- Digital Measures
 - -Timeline indicates July 15 as "soft" deadline for individual faculty decision of how they wish their CV information to be uploaded, with or without assistance
 - -Student workers being hired to enter data

 - -Campus Carry Task Force recommendations being reviewed by President's Cabinet
