FACULTY SENATE BULLET POINTS

- President Trauth has formed a Campus Carry Task Force to plan for the August 1, 2016 implementation of
 the licensed carrying of loaded handguns on our campuses. Special Assistant to the President, Dr. Vicki
 Brittain, will chair the committee, which will comprise 26 stakeholder representatives. The effort will
 include broad, inclusive discussions to solicit input from all quarters. Please convey your comments and
 concerns about the implementation of campus carry to your <u>Faculty Senators</u>, <u>Senate Liaisons</u> or via the
 president's <u>Campus Carry</u> website by completing a brief survey.
- Beginning this semester, all <u>HB2504</u> Student Perceptions of Instruction surveys will be conducted online.
 Data from Fall 2013 Fall 2014 online trials showed that the response rates were lower, but the
 distribution of responses was generally in line with surveys conducted in hard copy during classes in prior
 years. After two years, a review of SPI surveys will be conducted to assess the effectiveness of capturing
 student perceptions via online delivery.
- A new category of Presidential Awards for Excellence in Teaching has been approved. There will
 henceforth be separate awards for Assistant Professors and full-time Lecturers. Consult <u>PPS 6.11</u> for
 details.
- <u>Microsoft Unified Messaging</u> will replace the CallPilot voicemail system by Spring 2016. A new feature is that phone messages will also appear as email.
