President's Academic Advisory Group (PAAG)

Graduate enrollment, President Trauth

- Goals for universities our size are to have attractive programs; niches people want; funding of graduate students as a priority for philanthropic fundraising
- Poised to increase masters enrollment in some fields, recruited at program level
- Ideal target for enrollment 12-15% at graduate level

Strategies to increase graduate enrollment, Golato

- Participation in information sessions for Graduate College and programs; college fairs; collaborate with MBA recruiter; McNair Scholars (for diversity)
- Graduate Council meets monthly to discuss recruitment and admissions to use current recruitment strategies and share toolkit of best practices
- Design templates for recruitment efforts
- Individual consultations with departments, undergraduate advisors
- Pilot project to advertise grad programs on the web; colleges of Business and Education to attract working professionals; will target *Austin American Statesman*
- Long-term project of surveying students modeled on Northwestern system
- Research presentations for graduate student conference
- Online masters programs, Merrick funds may be utilized, graduate advisors and faculty should be included in planning

National Research University status, Trauth, Bourgeois

• An evolutionary process, approximately a decade before the university attains sufficient tier one funding

Space utilization, Trauth

• State-wide, Texas State is at the top in space utilization formula, but some changes may improve efficiency

Online courses, Thorne

- Ability to take classes online is an important factor for many students in their decision to enroll
- Texas State has only 11 courses 50% or more online. These come from faculty who think their discipline is appropriate for online (often graduate students, focused, independent)

- More undergraduate online courses are being developed and planned, originating from departments
- Western Governors University is online, competency-based; Northern Arizona is among first to implement competency-based programs
