Summary of the Library Committee's 2012-13 endeavors/accomplishments:

- 1. Library Allocation Formula: The Library Committee, based on subcommittee and library staff work related to several predictor models, will recommend changes to the formula, especially in response to changes necessitated by acquiring large journal packages.
- 2. Library Research Grant funds: A subcommittee selected faculty to receive the Library Research Funds; \$25,000 was available.
- 3. Online Resource Grants Subcommittee: Another subcommittee met to review requests for funds from the \$160,000 available for one-time acquisitions of large data bases that faculty use for research and classes.
- 4. Joan Heath updated/informed committee members at each of our three meetings regarding other library initiatives.
