REMEDIAL ORDER

ON THIS DATE appeared _____, the Child in the above-styled and numbered cause, having being found to have engaged in Truant Conduct, and this Court enters the following **ORDERS**:

- attend school without unexcused absences;
- attend a preparatory class for the high school equivalency examination due to the Court's determination that the Child is unlikely to do well in a formal classroom environment due to the Child's age;
- take the high school equivalency examination administered under Section 7.111, Education Code due to the Court's finding that it is in the best interest of the child (*applicable only if the Child is at least 16 years of age*);
- attend the following non-profit special program that the Court has determined to be in the best interest of the child:
 - alcohol program;
 - drug abuse program;
 - rehabilitation program;
 - counseling, including self-improvement counseling;
 - training in self-esteem and leadership;
 - work and job skills training;
 - training in parenting, including parental responsibility;
 - training in manners;
 - training in violence avoidance;
 - sensitivity training;
 - training in advocacy and mentoring;
 - other: _____;
- complete _____ hours (*not more than 50 total hours, not more than 16 hours per week*) of community service on a project acceptable to the Court, to wit: _____;
- participate in a tutorial program provided by the school the child attends covering the academic subjects in which the child is enrolled for _____ hours.

The Court has ordered the Department of Public Safety (DPS) in a separate order to:

- suspend** the driver's license or permit of the Child until _____ (*insert date not to exceed 180 days or until the end of the school year, whichever is later*).
- deny the issuance** of a driver's license or permit to the Child until _____ (*insert date not to exceed 180 days or until the end of the school year, whichever is later*).

Having allowed an opportunity to be heard and considered the financial ability to pay \$50.00, the Court hereby:

- WAIVES** the court cost, finding that _____, (*the Child, Child's parent, or Other person responsible for the Child's support*) is not financially able to pay the \$50 court cost.
- ORDERS** that the court cost be paid by:
