### **Board of Regents' Review (#500)**

President Trauth and Cabinet members welcomed guests, Dr. Alex White, Faculty Senate Chair; Mr. Noel Fuller, Staff Council Chair; Ms. Alison Castillo, Student Government President; and Mr. Jayme Blaschke to the meeting and provided a review of the upcoming May 23-24, 2019, Board of Regents (BOR) meeting.

### **Board of Regents News Release (#626)**

President Trauth, Cabinet members, and guest, Mr. Blaschke, discussed topics for inclusion in the news release about the May 2019 BOR meeting. Mr. Blaschke will prepare a release about a 10-year lease agreement between Texas State and Kerbey Lane Cafe, Inc.

### **Social Media**

Provost Bourgeois and guest, Mr. Dan Eggers, discussed developing a policy pertaining to university social media feeds. Cabinet members suggested to add to this policy behavioral expectations related to social media feeds linked to university webpages for chartered and registered student organizations. Dr. Lloyd will work with Mr. Eggers and Mr. Pierce to explore whether a new policy should be created or whether the information could be added to a preexisting policy.

Mr. Eggers sought clarification of certain assignments during an emergency. Cabinet members agreed that during an emergency, Ms. Caitlin Harvey will monitor social media and send out messages through social media, and Ms. Sandy Pantlik will craft messaging for the Safety and Emergency Communications website. In light of the division of duties, Mr. Eggers will give Ms. Pantlik access to the Safety and Emergency Communications website.

### **President's Update (#556)**

President Trauth continued the discussion on developing a plan for communicating to the university community about an incident that resulted in four students being arrested on May 1, 2019. As part of this plan, President Trauth would like to engage students by identifying forums where conversations can be had about important issues.
