Provost Bourgeois announced that the Child Development Center will close, beginning the week after Spring Break, due to insufficient staffing levels to meet accreditation requirements.

President's Cabinet charged Assistant Vice President of University Communications Ms. Sandy Pantlik with crafting a Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs) webpage. Mr. Algoe announced that the Human Resources Office has begun drafting FAQs related to leave and will work with Ms. Pantlik to finalize.

Mr. Algoe led a discussion on temporary exceptions to Texas State's telecommuting and working remotely policies.

Cabinet members continued the discussion on study abroad. TSUS policy requires all students in study abroad programs in countries with a level 3 warning to return home.

Dr. Sriraman Vedaraman, Associate Vice President for Academic Affairs, asked Cabinet members to consider whether allowing students, who ask to remain abroad, to sign a consent form.

Dr. Smith led a discussion on the Student Recreation Center. Cabinet members agreed to reduce hours and employ measures to promote social distancing.

Dr. Smith led a discussion on the Student Health Center. Dr. Emilio Carranco reported that the Student Health Center will be transitioning to providing more services via telehealth after Spring Break.
