Dr. Damphousse's First Meeting with President's Cabinet

President Damphousse shared his vision and discussed the next three months. Primary areas of focus will be: student enrollment and retention; student engagement, including the role that Athletics will play in the overall student experience; donor and alumni engagement; faculty and staff support; and strategic planning driven by Texas State University's goal of becoming an R1 institution. Potential opportunities for growth are growing online offerings and expanding international recruitment initiatives. In the upcoming weeks, President Damphousse will convene task forces to make recommendations, develop plans, and guide efforts around a few of these priorities.

President Damphousse announced that University Communications will move out of University Advancement, though he needs more time to determine the specifics of the reorganization and timeline. He cited the launch of the Vice President for University Advancement (VPUA) search as the impetus because a decision had to be made regarding the responsibilities and expectations of the next VPUA.
