Faculty and Staff Organization Request

Dr. Lloyd presented a proposal to create a new faculty and staff organization, "Lemonade Squad." Cabinet members wholeheartedly appreciated the intent of the proposal, and because it aligned with the mission of Staff Council, recommended that the group proposing the new organization meet with Staff Council to discuss the possibility of forming a subcommittee under their oversight. This unites their intentions with those of Staff Council and should prevent additional administrative burdens for all involved.

- Assist with attainment of recruitment and retention goals through on-campus living.

President's Report

President Damphousse discussed the termination of football coach Jake Spavital, reiterating his well-wishes for Coach Spavital and his family. He also provided a brief update on the national search for the next head football coach.

President Damphousse announced that the next Cabinet Advance will be in January. At that time, Cabinet members will discuss recommendations from five presidential commissions, task forces, and workgroups, develop plans for implementation of the approved recommendations, and identify strategic cost reduction opportunities.
