Summary and Action Items

• UPPS 04.04.53: Honors and Benefits for Retired Faculty and Staff: Dr. Everette Swinney and Dr. Marianne Reese gave an overview of the current activities of the Retired Faculty and Staff Association.

• PPS 5.05: Additional Compensation for Additional Duties for Faculty Paid 100 Percent from Sponsored Programs (Final Approval): A comment was received to add a statement that this PPS pertains to tenure and tenure-track faculty. Policy was approved with this change.

• **PPS 5.06: Incentive Compensation for Externally Funded Sponsored Programs** (Final Approval): Three comments were discussed. Policy was approved with changes to paragraph 4 & 10.

• **PPS 9.03: Academic Affairs Computing Priority Committee Project (Final Approval)**: The purpose statement will remain the same and the committee will have two faculty nominated by Faculty Senate. Policy was approved with these two changes.

• Residency, Advanced Hours, and BA Requirements (RTA from 6/26/07): Due to the absence of several Deans, this item will be returned to the agenda for the September 11, 2007 CAD meeting.

• **Commencement**: Dr. Debbie Thorne announced that a practice walk-through of the commencement ceremony will be held on Thursday, August 9th at 3:30. Deans are encouraged to attend due to the changes made to the ceremony.

• **SACS**: Dr. Cathy Fleuriet distributed the list of principles of accreditation that require a response from the Provost.

• **LBJ Distinguished Lecture Series Committee Principles**: Dr. Moore distributed the updated committee charge and membership of the LBJ Distinguished Lecture Series Committee.
