Council of Academic Deans Meeting March 31, 2020

Summary and Action Items

1. Threats to Academic Freedom related to Remote Teaching (social media posts have been identified encouraging students to share video evidence of faculty teaching "radicalism." – Discussion was held amongst the Council regarding threats to academic freedom with classes being online/remote for this semester. The Provost will communicate to campus the responsibilities of students and rights of faculty in the learning environment.

2. **COVID-19 Updates** – Dr. Bourgeois announced various actions approved by the President's Cabinet in response to COVID-19.

- Dr. Bourgeois announced that Cabinet was working to finalize a statement to campus regarding students having the option to request modification of final course grades to an EP grade after final grades are awarded.
- Dr. Bourgeois announced that Cabinet approved offering online and remote delivery of courses for Summer I. As of today, Summer II courses will be face-to-face as well as online and remote delivery but TXST will continue monitoring guidance from local health officials.
- Dr. Bourgeois reviewed a proposal with the Council to pay students a \$50 per SCH emergency aid grant for Summer I 2020 classes.
- Dr. Bourgeois noted that Cabinet reviewed all renovation projects and discussed a few projects that are delayed/deferred to a later date.
- Ms. Tammy Sharp provided an overview with the Council regarding the Families First Coronavirus Response Act and its implementation regarding staff.
