## Council of Academic Deans November 21, 2006

## **Summary and Action Items**

• University Mentoring Program: Dr. Rod Fluker spoke to the Council about the University Mentoring Program and asked the Deans for their participation in a one-hour meeting with students who are mentees. He explained what the program is and its mission.

• **Faculty Development Leave Applications**: Dr. Moore asked the Council for any questions/comments on the applicants. The Council had no objections and all applicants were approved.

• **Distinguished Professor Emeritus**: All of the nominees for Distinguished Professor Emeritus were approved by the Council.

• **Developing Proposals for New Doctoral Degree Programs**: Dr. Fleuriet reminded the Council of the upcoming workshop regarding the set up of proposals for new doctoral programs. She distributed a handout of an e-mail that went to all faculty from Dr. Beth Wuest as a reminder to the Council.

• **Summary Activity for Grants and Contracts**: Dr. Covington distributed the proposal activity for September and October.

• **Target of Opportunities**: Dr. Bourgeois announced that 9 candidates had been approved and were to be contacted by their departments.

• **Budget Transfers**: Dr. Bourgeois announced that Faculty Records is continuing to make budget transfers including funds for new faculty positions.

• Dr. Bourgeois also announced that he will attend the Council of Chairs meeting in December to discuss the M&O Budget Reform and proposal to eliminate course fees.

• **Board of Regents Update**: Dr. Moore announced that the Board of Regents approved the elimination and conversion of all course fees to designated tuition, which corresponds to a \$9.00 per semester credit hour increase, which includes an additional 20% to be set aside for financial aid and scholarships.

• Advising Fee: Dr. Moore also announced that there was no proposal to increase the advising fee.
