• Curriculum Proposals:

- Delete the Bachelor of Music major in Jazz Studies and add a Jazz concentration under the Bachelor of Music major in Performance
- Add Master of Science in Nursing major in Family Nurse Practitioner
- Delete the Master of Arts in Applied Geography major in Geography Land Management
- Delete the Master of Arts major in Health Psychology and add a Master of Arts major in Psychological Research
- Change the Bachelor of Science in Family and Consumer Sciences major in Family and Consumer Sciences to a major in Consumer Affairs and change the minor in Consumer Science to Consumer Affairs

All proposals were approved.
