### Requirements and General Information:

Scholarships are intended to financially assist and reward incoming and current students pursuing a major in the Department of Agricultural Sciences. To receive a scholarship, students must enroll as a full-time student (12 semester hours), and enroll in at least one agriculture class each semester. Students will receive funds on a semester basis in acheck issued after the 12<sup>th</sup> class day. Recipients should be prepared to make an installment on or pay in full their tuition (at the first installment deadline) prior to the receipt of a scholarship check issued after the 12<sup>th</sup> class day. To receive the second half of their scholarship in the spring, students must maintain the following guidelines:

- 1. All scholarship recipients must be pursuing a course of study in the Department of Agricultural Sciences.
- 2. All Scholarship recipients must be a citizen of the United States and able to provide a valid Social Security Number.
- 3. All Scholarship recipients must be a resident of Texas and graduate of a Texas public, private, or home school on or after May 2020.
- 4. Enroll in a minimum of twelve (12) semester hours per semester in a specific agriculture major degree plan during advance registration.
- 5. All Scholarship recipients must earn a minimum grade point average of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale each semester (not cumulative) of each academic year to remain eligible to receive further disbursements of Scholarship funds.
- 6. Three of the five scholarship recipients must be from the Donor's market area (Bexar, Kendall, Comal, Guadalupe, Wilson, Atascosa, Frio, Medina and Bandera counties).
