Requirements and General Information:

Scholarships are intended to financially assist and reward incoming and current students pursuing a major in the Department of Agricultural Sciences. To receive a scholarship, students must enroll as a full-time student (12 semester hours), and enroll in at least one agriculture class each semester. Students will receive funds on a semester basis in a check issued after the 12th class day. Recipients should be prepared to make an installment on or pay in full their tuition (at the first installment deadline) prior to the receipt of a scholarship check issued after the 12th class day. To receive the second half of their scholarship in the spring, students must maintain the following guidelines:

1. All scholarship recipients must be pursuing a course of study in the Department of Agricultural Sciences.
2. All Scholarship recipients must be a citizen of the United States and able to provide a valid Social Security Number.
3. All Scholarship recipients must be a resident of Texas and graduate of a Texas public, private, or home school on or after May 2020.
4. Enroll in a minimum of twelve (12) semester hours per semester in a specific agriculture major degree plan during advance registration.
5. All Scholarship recipients must earn a minimum grade point average of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale each semester (not cumulative) of each academic year to remain eligible to receive further disbursements of Scholarship funds.
6. Three of the five scholarship recipients must be from the Donor's market area (Bexar, Kendall, Comal, Guadalupe, Wilson, Atascosa, Frio, Medina and Bandera counties).
