	Update: Continuing to field concerns and communicate them with the
	President's office. Developed a concerns webpage to specifically address
	comments and concerns by staff on the website. There is also a FAQ section on
	our website for comments coming into Staff Council. University library update
	included in the handout. The Presidents Health, Wellness, and Safety work
	group will address the issue of requesting visitors/guests to wear face masks
	when we return face-to-face. Information will be forthcoming.

	Noel Fuller is on the Faculty/Staff Morale work group. They will be meeting later this week. Items from zoom attendees to address: additional information pertaining to staff similar to the weekly emails distributed for faculty; inconsistencies in messages i.e. virtual commencement but yet we have summer II in person); information on why decisions are being made to go with decisions.
	Additional questions/comments to share with President Trauth: 1) Why are we bringing students back in Summer II if there is a likelihood that we will have to send them back home. 2) Why not have Summer I and Summer II online and then try to get ready for the fall face-to-face. 3) It doesn't make sense to do Summer II face-to-face but not commencement, what is the reasoning? 4) Information is filtering differently in divisions; there needs to be a centralized communication stream. 5) Are there ways to show our contracted custodians our appreciation for the work they are doing?
<b>ACTION</b> (10:30)	<ul> <li>Item 3: By-Law Revisions (handout)</li> <li>Council Effectiveness Committee</li> <li>We have 25-28 positions available for staff council but can normally only fill 21-23 positions. The intent behind the proposed changes is to make it easier to fill all slots. Proposed changes to membership to move to staff members who have been employed 6 months but not a requirement. There is also a recommendation to update the standing operating budget section.</li> <li>Illona Weber motioned to approve the amended by-laws, Amanda Garza second, motion passed, no opposition.</li> </ul>
<b>UPDATE</b> (10:45)	Item 4: Elections (handout) Martin Zavala, Elections Committee We are migrating to a new voting process on Qualtrics. Staff will be able to nominate and vote outside of their EEO category so start thinking about people you would like to represent you. You can also self-nominate. Staff Council is planning to do direct outreach of the Services category to encourage more involvement. Traditionally this group is difficult to get representation for due to the various natures of their shift work.
DISCUSSION (11:00)	Item 5: Meeting Recording Protocol Noel Fuller, Chair Now that Zoom recording is available, Staff Council wants to discuss options for recording meetings. There is a notification when you come into a meeting that it's being recorded and there is a concern about having meetings recorded that may make people hesitate to share their thoughts. Someone might not want to speak up if it's posted for everyone to see. One suggestion would be to record and post the guest speakers but not allow recording during the meeting. Alternate suggestion was to record portions of meetings but leaving a time during the meeting that isn't recorded so that staff could speak openly.
