## Withdrawal Refunds

Reducing semester credit hours to zero is considered a withdrawal and withdrawal refund policies apply. You MUST do this through the <u>Registrar's Office</u>. Students receiving financial aid must contact the <u>Financial Aid Office</u>.

An immediate refund **WILL NOT** be made at the time a student withdraws. Any refund will be applied to remaining unpaid obligations. If a student has paid in full, a refund will be processed within 30 days.
