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## A Resolution-

A resolution to be known as "A Resolution to Establish Required Equal Employment Opportunity and Title IX training for ALL Graduate Student Workers", which calls for mandated training for all graduate student workers, which includes but not limited to instructional assistants, teaching assistants, research assistants, lab, learning, and classroom assistants, and graders, in order to be informed on their roles as Responsible Employees of Texas State University.

1	WHEREAS:	Texas State University is firmly committed to maintaining
2		an educational environment free from all forms of
3		discrimination on the basis of sex; and
4	WHEREAS:	Texas law requires that all state agencies provide equal
5		employment opportunity training to all employees within 30
6		days of hire and every <a href="two">two</a> years thereafter; and
7	WHEREAS:	Ongoing research and descriptive statistics indicate a
8		<pre>pattern of sexual and dating violence is prevalent across</pre>
9		U.S. college campuses; and
10	WHEREAS:	This pattern highlights a need for U.S. colleges and
11		universities to further educate students about their
12		responsibilities for reporting instances of sexual

13		harassment and sexual assault and to foster an atmosphere
14		intolera <u>nt</u> of sexual misconduct; and
15	WHEREAS:	Responsible Employee refers to a campus employee, including
16		<pre>graduate student workers, who has the authority to redress</pre>
17		sexual misconduct $_{\underline{\prime}}$ who has the duty to report incidents of
18		sexual misconduct to the <u>Texas State's</u> Title IX Coordinator
19		or other appropriate designee, or whom a student could
20		reasonably believe has this authority or duty; therefore
21	BE IT RESO	LVED: That all Texas State University graduate student
22		workers receive at minimum, mandatory Equal Employment
23		Opportunity and Title IX training; and
24	BE IT FURT	THER RESOLVED: That upon passage this piece of legislation
25		be forwarded to Graduate Dean Andrea Golato
26		and Title IX Coordinator Gilda Garcia for
27		further action.
