26	ARTICLE I. ADMINISTRATIVE		

§1 MEETING AND PURPOSE. In order to provide oversight of

the budget and expenditures, the Finance Commission

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shall meet every week starting the last week of August and while the Senate is in session with the exception of holidays.

- PRESIDENTIAL REPORTING. The President, the Director of Finance or a designee shall provide the commission with documentation of expenditures and issue a report on the state of the budget including, but not limited to, current expenditures from each category and line item at each meeting of the commission.
- §3 PRESIDENTIAL POWERS. The President shall have the power to reallocate remaining funds from each category and line item should the activity funded be completed or invalidated with any such changes reported to the

invalidated, with any such changes reported to the Finance Commission at its next regularly scheduled meeting.

ARTICLE II. AUTHORIZATION

\$1 **DEFINITION AND ORGANIZATION.** Where each word is bolded it shall be considered a category of the budget and where each word is indented it shall be considered a line item

of the budget and where each word is followed by an asterisk it shall denote a mandatory expense category. That
