- 1 A Bill-
- 2 To be entitled "The Candidate Election Notification Act"
- 3 relating to notifying candidates of election results after
- 4 student government elections.
- 5 WHEREAS: The Student Government Constitution does not require the
- 6 Election Board to directly notify candidates of their
- 7 victory or defeat in Student Government Elections; and
- 8 WHEREAS: This showed in the Spring 2022 election, where candidates
- 9 for the Senate were not directly notified by the Election
- 10 Board after election certification; and

- 11 WHEREAS: The election announcement "party" was not well-
- 12 advertised, causing myself and other candidates to not
- know about, and thus miss, it; and
- 14 WHEREAS: A singular evening get-together to announce results can
- 15 conflict with other activities that may cause candidates
- to not be able to attend it; and
- 17 WHEREAS: It is important that candidates get directly notified of
- their victory or defeat in student government elections
- 19 to make the election process easier on candidates and more
- legitimate to the public; therefore
- 21 BE IT ENACTED: That the Election Board shall be required to
- 22 directly notify all candidates in Student Government
- elections of their victory or defeat; and
- 24 BE IT FURTHER ENACTED: This direct notification shall specifically
- be performed via emails to candidates' school email
- addresses, sent out within 24 hours of the official
- 27 certification of election results.
- 28 BE IT FURTHER ENACTED: This legislation be forwarded to the
- 29 Student Body President for further action.
