Available



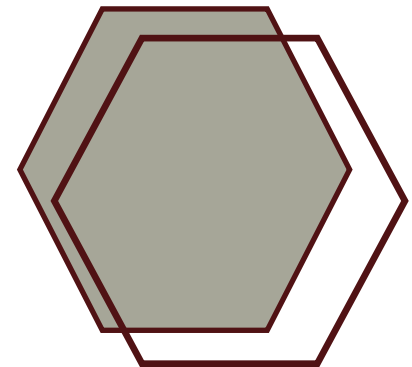
Scanning Services (Faculty)
