Glass-Bottom Boat Ride*

Length: 30 minutes (can be extended to 45 minutes on request)

Age Appropriate for: All Ages

As you glide across Spring Lake in Glass Bottom Boats, you have a rare opportunity to see underwater life from a different perspective. View over 1,000 springs that bubble up 150 million gallons a day of clear water from the Edwards Aquifer to form Spring Lake, the headwaters of the San Marcos River. Declared a Critical Habitat by the Federal Government in 1980, Spring Lake is the home of five endangered species. Tour time is approximately 30 minutes.

Birthday Banner and Face Painting*

Length: 15 min

Age Appropriate for: All Ages

You party guests will color a fun birthday banner for the birthday boy or girl. During this time our tour guide will provide face painting!

Bug Picking*

Length: 30 minutes

Age Appropriate for: Modifications available for Pre-K through High School

Choose from 2 different versions: Water Quality or Food Chains

Enjoy Spring Lake's most popular interactive activity! Students can explore the interesting world of bugs through the Spring Lake Bug Picking Activity! Students will conduct an experiment in order to test the quality of the water at Spring Lake based on the bugs they find or in order to discover the water food chain or food web of invertebrates! This is a fun interactive activity that really allows students to get a bugs eye view!

Wetlands Bug Bingo

Length: 15 minutes

Age Appropriate for: 6 years and up (need to be able to read)

This activity goes hand in hand with Bug Picking. Students will learn what different aquatic bugs look like and how to identify them while playing a fun game of "Wetlands Bug Bingo".

Frog Food Chain*

Length: 15 minutes

Age Appropriate for: 3rd-high school Activity Level High (running game)

During this interactive game your guests will pretend to be Frogs competing with each other for prey while avoiding the predator herons in our Wetlands food chain. What our Frogs don't know is that there is a twist to this game... this Wetlands Habitat has been polluted! How will the Frogs survive...?

The Great Frog Race*

Length: 15 minutes

Age Appropriate for: PreK-4th Activity Level High (running game)

Oh No! Our pretend wetlands habitat has before polluted with trash. We must race against time to save our frogs one by one. This fun obstacle course is sure to be a hit at your party.

Flubber*

Length: 15 minutes – 30 minutes

Age Appropriate for: All ages (with help from adults)

Warning: Messy Fun!

Ooey, Gooey, Slimy Fun! Your party guests will have a great time making Flubber from our slimy recipe. You'll even get to take a baggy home to play with! (Makes a great party favor).

Spring Lake Scavenger Hunt*

Length: 1 hour

Age Appropriate for: 3rd and up

Guests will go on a fun Scavenger Hunt hike on the preserve next to Spring Lake.

The Water Conservation Game

Length: 15 minutes

Age Appropriate for: 3rd-high school

This trivia game explores the theme of conserving water. Teams compete to see who can successfully save the most water!

During this interactive activity, students learn how little fresh water is available for use by all living things.
