
DIY BINOCULARS

Supplies:

- 2 Toilet Paper Rolls
- Hole Puncher
- Yarn or String
- Scissors
- White Glue
- Construction Paper
- Decorating Supplies (Markers, Crayons, Stickers, Tissue Paper)

Directions:

- 1. First, wrap the toilet paper rolls in construction paper for decoration (Optional).
- Now, get the 2 toilet paper rolls and glue them together side by side. Wait for them to dry before moving on to step 3.
- 3. Decorate the binoculars with your supplies.
- 4. Punch holes in the side of the binoculars about 1/2 inch away from the top. If you don't have
 - a hole puncher you can use scissors to make the holes.



- 6. Thread the ends of the strings in both holes and tie knots to secure it on.
- 7. Go enjoy your new binoculars in the backyard or front yard and get up close to plants or look up at the clouds or play "I Spy" from inside.
