

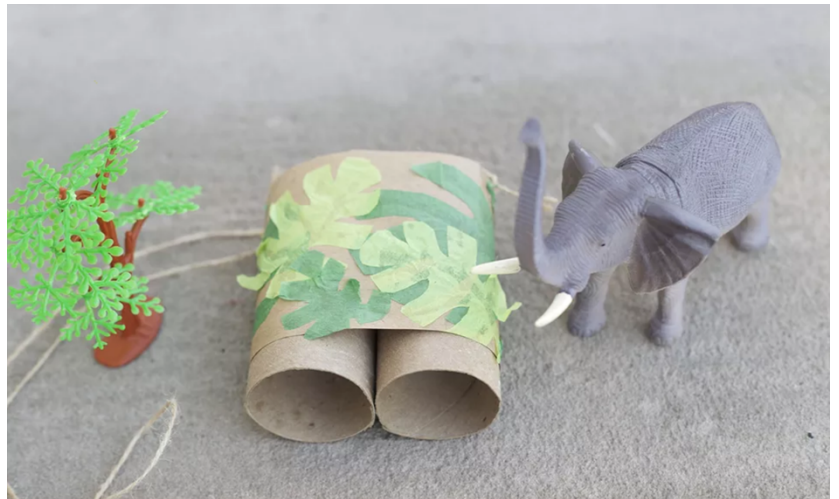
# DIY BINOCULARS

## Supplies:

- 2 Toilet Paper Rolls
- Hole Puncher
- Yarn or String
- Scissors
- White Glue
- Construction Paper
- Decorating Supplies (Markers, Crayons, Stickers, Tissue Paper)

## Directions:

1. First, wrap the toilet paper rolls in construction paper for decoration (Optional).
2. Now, get the 2 toilet paper rolls and glue them together side by side. Wait for them to dry before moving on to step 3.
3. Decorate the binoculars with your supplies.
4. Punch holes in the side of the binoculars about 1/2 inch away from the top. If you don't have a hole puncher you can use scissors to make the holes.
5. Cut the string at the appropriate length so that you can let your binoculars rest around your neck. I would recommend about 2 feet.
6. Thread the ends of the strings in both holes and tie knots to secure it on.
7. Go enjoy your new binoculars in the backyard or front yard and get up close to plants or look up at the clouds or play "I Spy" from inside.
