

DIY TIN CAN PLANTER

How to make a tin can into a nice flowerpot

Supplies needed:

- Tin can
- Hammer
- Nail
- Paint
- Small plant
- Soil
- Rocks



Directions:

1. Remove any labels from the tin can, wash with hot water, and dry.
2. On the bottom of the can, use the hammer and nail to make several holes for drainage.
3. Paint the outside and the top half of the inside of the can. Let dry.
4. Place a few layers of rocks in the bottom of the can. Use soil to fill the remaining space in the can.
5. Plant the small plant in the soil.
