### **Meeting Minutes – January 30, 2020**

There were no changes to the minutes from the January 30, 2020 meeting. Minutes have been posted to the website.

### **President's Cabinet Updates**

No new updates were reported.

### **New Proposals**

No new proposals were presented at the meeting.

### **Game Day Revenue Report**

Mr. Prentice presented the 2019 Game Day Profit and Loss statement. Total net revenue for Parking during Game day in 2019 was \$52652.78. Total Expenses was \$72,588,82. This resulted in a net loss for 2019 of -\$19,936.04. Mr. Prentice also went over previous year reports to compare several years. They were as follows.

2018: -\$10,290.85

2017: -\$5,842.38

2016: -\$13,035.48

2015: -\$9,978.51

### **Discussion of Parking Rules and Regulations**

Mr. Prentice presented two possible rule changes for this year.

1. Currently, community members are allowed to buy a parking permit. Mr. Prentice has proposed eliminating this option because of the list of other options available to the community for parking on campus.
2. People who park in the pay-to-park garages can pull a ticket, park in the garage all week and then pull a lost ticket and only pay \$14 for one day of parking. Mr. Prentice proposed adding language to current rules that will address this issue.

### **Discussion of Draft of Parking Concepts Proposal**

A draft proposal plan for building construction and parking on campus for the years of 2020-2023 was presented to the group. This presentation was also given at the January 2020 TSAC meeting. The

presentation included projects that are either completed or in the planning stages for more housing on campus and the effect it will have on parking. There was a discussion among the group and questions were answered regarding current plans and other possible options. This will be brought to TSAC again as projects in the plan are closer so there can be more discussion about possible parking rule changes due to the new construction.
