To be considered a full-time student for financial aid purposes, you must enroll in 12 credit hours as an undergraduate student (or 9 credit hours as a graduate student) that count toward your degree. To be eligible for most federal grants or loans, you must be enrolled at least halftime in courses that satisfy a degree requirement. Remember, to be eligible for most financial aid, you only need to be enrolled at least half-time (6 hours for undergraduate students and 5 hours for graduate students).
