3+2 Athletic Training Program

Students declared with the Pre-Rehabilitation Sciences concentration can apply for competitive admission to a combined degree program that allows undergraduate students to enter the Master of Science in Athletic Training program at the beginning of their senior year, to earn a Bachelor of Science in Exercise and Sports Science (BESS) and a Master of Science in Athletic Training (MSAT) degree in a total of just five (5) years.

NCAA Athletes:

Due to scheduling for their sport(s), NCAA Athletes are unable to fulfill the time commitment required for this pathway. If interested in becoming an Athletic Trainer, they should declare and complete the traditional Pre-Rehabilitation Sciences bachelor's degree program during their years of eligibility and enter a graduate program afterward.

- on track to have all required prerequisite coursework completed in the spring of Year 3
- performance in specific prerequisite coursework will also be considered
