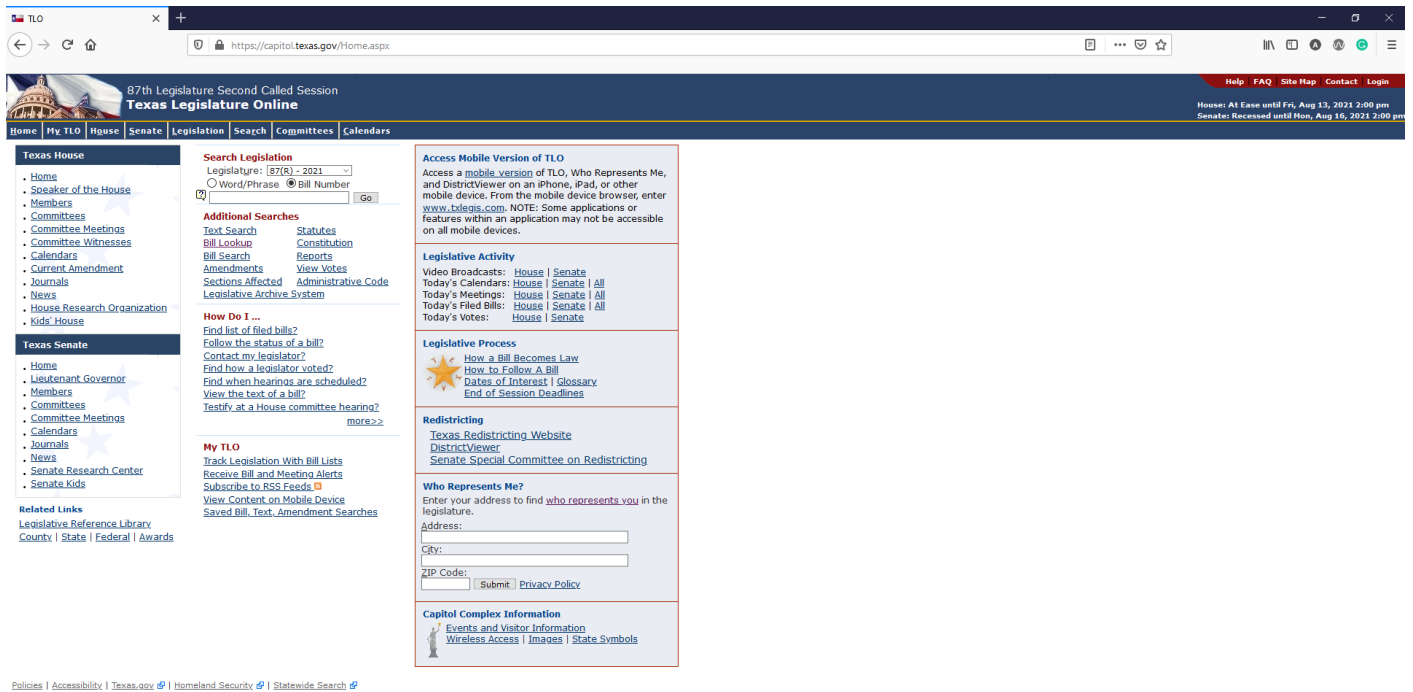


How To Use Texas Legislature Online (TLO)

Finding a Bill:

1. Navigate <https://capitol.texas.gov/>



2. Make sure you have the right session selected under "Search Legislation".
 - a. This session = "88(R) – 2023" (the special sessions have a number – in the order they were called – in parentheses instead of an 'R')



3. Choose either “Word/Phrase” or “Bill Number” depending on how you want to search.
 - a. If searching by bill number, make sure to put “SB” or “HB” (as applicable) in front of the number.

2. Once you find your bill, click on the "Text" tab at the top of the "History" screen.
