2 To be known as "A Full Thanksgiving Break Resolution" calling for 3 the University to implement a full and considerate Thanksgiving 4 break from the initial Monday of Thanksgiving to the following 5 Friday.

6 WHEREAS: There has not been a viable option for Fall break
7 presented previously; and

8 WHEREAS: There is no reason to have students attend monotonous9 classes prior to Thanksgiving in which often times

10 they are cancelled regardless; and

11 WHEREAS: We believe the implementation of a break leading up to 12 Thanksgiving is necessary to ensure the health, and 13 safety of the student body prior to traveling for

14 Thanksgiving; and

15 WHEREAS: This resolution helps establish precedent for a full Thanksgiving week break for all students; therefore, 16 17 18 BE IT RESOLVED: That the University implement a full 19 Thanksgiving break giving time off 20 between the first and next weekend 21 surrounding the holiday of 22 Thanksgiving; and 23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: This legislation be forwarded to the 24 Student Body President for further 25 action.
