2 To be known as "A Resolution Condemning the Chinese Communist
3 Party's Repression of the Uighur community in the Xinjiang
4 Autonomous Region."

5 **WHEREAS:** The Chinese government has been detaining Uighur Muslims
6 for the purpose of "re-education" since 2014; and

7 **WHEREAS:** There is evidence of inhumane forced labor and
8 sterilization of women, and

9 **WHEREAS:** The U.S. Department of State concluded that the Chinese
10 government committed crimes against humanity, and

11 **WHEREAS:** It is crucial that Student Government show support to the
12 Muslim and Uighur community at Texas State University; therefore,

13 **BE IT RESOLVED:** That the Student Government Senate condemns the
14 Chinese Communist Party's persecution of the Uighur community in
15 Xinjiang; and

16 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:** If passed, this resolution be
17 forwarded to the Student Body President for action.
