1 A Resolution

- 2 To be known as "The Advancement of Personal Pronouns Resolution,"
- 3 which calls on the university to affirm the $1^{\rm st}$ amendment right to
- 4 free speech by not interfering in the use of preferred names and
- 5 pronouns by its students.
- 6 WHEREAS: In its mission statement, "[Texas State University]
- 7 strives to create new knowledge, to embrace a diversity of people
- 8 and ideas, to foster cultural and economic development, and to
- 9 prepare its graduates to participate fully and freely as citizens
- 10 of Texas, the nation, and the world."; and
- 11 WHEREAS: The University Strategic Plan confirms that "A diversity
- 12 of people and ideas, a spirit of inclusiveness, a global
- 13 perspective, and a sense of community as essential conditions for
- 14 campus life" as one of the Universities Shared Values; and
- 15 WHEREAS: Student Government recognizes that Texas State Students
- 16 have the right to free speech; and
- 17 WHEREAS: Transgender, gender non-conforming, and students who do
- 18 not adhere to the gender binary have the right to refer to
- 19 themselves however they please as it is their First Amendment
- 20 right; and
- 21 WHEREAS: The current practice, requiring the use of legal names
- 22 in many University Systems, violates the First Amendment right of

- 23 members of the transgender and gender nonconforming community to
- 24 use their preferred name and pronoun; therefore,
- 25 **BE IT RESOLVED:** The Student Government of Texas State
- 26 University shares the transgender communities' concern regarding
- 27 their First Amendment right to use preferred names and pronouns;
- 28 and
- 29 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the Student Government of Texas
- 30 State University strongly encourages the university
- 31 administration, Registrar, and staff to review existing practices
- 32 and systems of record (Catsweb, Outlook, Canvas, Banner, etc.) to
- 33 ensure all campus community members are provided the First
- 34 Amendment right to identify their preferred name and pronoun; and
- 35 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:** The University adopt a University Policy
- 36 and Procedure Statement affirming students First Amendment right
- 37 to preferred naming and pronoun at the University; and
- 38 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:** This legislation be forwarded to the
- 39 Student Body President for further action.
