2 To be known as "A Resolution Establishing the Silkies Run as an
3 official university event" relating to raising public support for
4 the veteran community at Texas State University.

5 **WHEREAS:** The Student Government of Texas State University, on
6 behalf of the student body of Texas State University,
7 would like to address a visible lack of support for the
8 veteran community on campus; and

9 **WHEREAS:** There are currently 855 student veterans enrolled at Texas
10 State; and

11 **WHEREAS:** Many student veterans are unaware of the resources
12 available to them; and

13 **WHEREAS:** Currently there is minimal to no outreach to the veteran
14 community to inform them of the resources they have; and

15 **WHEREAS:** The Silkies Run provides an avenue to raise awareness to
16 the significance of the veteran community here at Texas
17 State University; therefore,

18 **BE IT RESOLVED:** That the Student Government calls on the University
19 to establish "The Silkies Run" as an official University
20 event; and

21 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:** This legislation be forwarded to the
22 Student Body President for further action.
