8 WHEREAS: The Student Government of Texas State University, on behalf of students who are already burdened by the potential charges, support less offenses when it comes to situations that relate to parking so that a student does not have to focus on paying for copious amounts of parking bills; and

14 WHEREAS: The Student Government should always support the
15 financial situation of a student attending Texas State
16 University And a Freshman or new year student who may
17 not know the parking limits at first; and

WHEREAS: An initial warning should be written, but as of this piece of legislation the second time a parking citation is issued this should be the first billable offense, however this should be the first citation to be contested against the university; and

23	WHEREAS: Many students who are active across the university,
24	including student organizations, potential employees,
25	and other parties that have business at our university
26	have been fined; and
27	WHEREAS: The simple understanding that a first warning system
28	should be implemented, following the first opportunity
29	to appeal a parking ticket should be implemented;
30	therefore,
31	BE IT RESOLVED: The university understands that students are
32	already dealing with financial issues, so the first
33	issued parking citation should be a warning; and
34	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: The first official citation should be
35	the first actual citation, after a written warning has
36	been issued, which can be appealed so that a student has
37	a technical last warning before actual fining against
38	the student; and
39	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: This legislation be forwarded to the

Student Body President for further action.
