A Resolution

To be known as "A calling for a mural of all students we have lost in the past years," where the Student Government calls for funds to be allocated for an artist to paint the students who we have lost so that they are always remembered as Bobcats.

WHEREAS: The Student Government of Texas State University, on behalf of the families and friends who have lost loved ones to circumstances that are related to COVID-19, the result to mental health, and other situations that have caused the loss of a fellow Bobcat; and

WHEREAS: The students who have been mourned by the Texas State population such as Khambrail Winters, Marc Rodriguez, Michael Jovais; and

WHEREAS: Any other students who can be remembered as a Bobcat, so that we may pay respect to the families and friends who have been deeply affected by the outcomes of their loss; and

WHEREAS: Texas State has never had a project of such a level that would establish a remembrance of all students who have been Bobcats to pay respects to the loss of such

21 great students, and even more to pay respects to the
22 parents who had such promise in this university; and
23 **WHEREAS:** Texas State University look into allocating funds that
24 may be used to create such a mural; therefore,
25 **BE IT RESOLVED:** That the families, and friends are respected by
26 the permanent remembrance via a mural on the property of
27 Texas State University; and
28 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:** The University is greatly encouraged to
29 allocate funds from departments willing to allocate
30 funds to fund the project; and
31 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:** Students of the College of Fine Arts may
32 allocate funds to properly fund students with the needed
33 funds and time to participate in this project; and
34 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:** That the mural is created before the
35 ending of December 2021, if not completed until December
36 2021 more time should be allocated until the mural is
37 completed.
38 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:** This legislation be forwarded to the
39 Student Body President for further action.
