- 2 To be known as "The Judicial Rectification Mandate," which
- 3 acknowledges and enforces the overdue annulment of the Supreme
- 4 Court Chief Justice's term in direct accordance with the Student
- 5 Government Constitution.

- 6 WHEREAS: Article VIII Section (3b) of the Student Government
- 7 Constitution reads "Justices will hold office for a term of
- 8 two years or until they resign, become ineligible to serve,
- 9 or are removed from office."; and

- 10 WHEREAS: Supreme Court Justice William Frank-Cadoree has served
- 11 as a Supreme Court Justice beginning as late as January
- 12 2019 under appointment of then Student Body President Ruben
- 13 Becerra; and
- 14 WHEREAS: As far as the Student Government of Texas State
- University is aware, Chief Justice William Frank-Cadoree
- 16 has served as Supreme Court Justice for longer than two
- 17 years beginning as late as January 2019; and
- 18 WHEREAS: William Frank-Cadoree has served for longer than the
- 19 two years the Student Government Constitution allows for a
- 20 justice to hold office as cited in Article VIII Section
- 21 (3b); and
- 22 WHEREAS: The spring 2021 portion of a term fulfilled by William
- 23 Frank-Cadoree in the role of Supreme Court Chief Justice is
- 24 null and void and has been since the beginning of the
- 25 semester; therefore,
- 26 **BE IT RESOLVED:** All activities of the Supreme Court overseen by
- William Frank-Cadoree since the Month of January, 2021 are
- 28 illegitimate and null and void; and
- 29 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the Student Government of Texas
- 30 State University does not recognize the false authority of
- 31 a supreme court that is being conned into acceptance of the
- illegal leadership of 'Chief Justice William Frank-Cadoree;
- 33 and
- 34 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the Student Government of Texas
- 35 State University will no longer be intimidated and
- 36 threatened into participating in the false court
- 37 proceedings led by the named student masquerading as Chief
- 38 Justice; and
- 39 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:** This legislation be forwarded to the
- 40 Student Body President for further action.
