A Resolution to be entitled "A Resolution for the Registration of Freshmen Students by the Dean of Students and University College," relating to the need to register incoming freshman to show the Student Body's desire to become more civically engage.

WHEREAS: The Student Government of Texas State University, on behalf of
the student body of Texas State University, would like to
address the lack of voter registration prominent amongst the
freshman class; and

WHEREAS: The university currently does not have a permanent mechanism
to assist in the enrollment of students to become registered
