### A Resolution -

To be known as "A Resolution in Support of a Permanent Space for Bobcat Bounty in the LBJ Student Center," which supports the allocation of existing or future space in the LBJ Student Center for the Bobcat Bounty Program and other food security resources.

1 WHEREAS: According to the Hays County Food Bank, 40% of Texas 2 State students experience some form of food 3 insecurity; and WHEREAS: Food insecurity can reduce students' academic 4 5 performance, affect mental health, and have physical 6 health side effects; and WHEREAS: Student Government wishes to address this issue by 7 supporting Bobcat Bounty with financial support from 8 9 the Student Government budget and through advocacy by 10 advancing the program's goals and institutional 11 longevity; therefore,

12	BE IT RESOLVED:	Student Government requests that the LBJ Student
13		Center Director provision a permanent space that
14		can be operated during business hours for Bobcat
15		Bounty and other food security programs in
16		existing available space or in a future yet-to-
17		be-renovated space in the LBJ Student Center;

19	BE IT RESOLVED:	Student Government will collaborate with the
20		Bobcat Bounty Steering Committee, the LBJ
21		Student Center Director, and other stakeholders
22		to find a space that fits the program's needs
23		and is appropriately accessible to students; and
24	BE IT RESOLVED:	Where possible and reasonable, Student
25		Government requests the LBJ Student Center
26		Director to support the Bobcat Bounty program
27		through acquisition or assignment of surplus
28		office supplies, such as computers, printers,
29		furniture, and other standard office equipment;
30		and
31	BE IT RESOLVED:	That upon passage, this resolution be forwarded
32		to the Student Body President for further
33		action.
