Elevate Student Success

Mr. Algoe continued the discussion about on-campus fees assessed to students enrolled in traditional in-person degree programs but taking online courses. The assessment of fees is based on several factors, including location and instructional modality. Cabinet members provided feedback, and Mr. Algoe will return to Cabinet with a final proposal.

Improve Operations and Enhance Infrastructure

Mr. Hull discussed private giving. Of worth noting, Step Up for State raised more than \$1.7M, and the Next is Now Capital Campaign, which will end Fall 2024, has raised nearly \$240M.
