FIRE Evacuation Procedures

If you discover SMOKE or FIRE



- →If not in immediate danger, call 9-1-1
- **▶**Activate nearest fire alarm pull station

If your building's FIRE ALARM activates:

- Prepare to exit building immediately
- •Close doors behind you
- •Evacuate building using nearest safe exit
- •If your primary evacuation route is blocked, use a secondary route
- DO NOT use elevators
- •Calmly walk to the designated assembly area for your building and assemble with your work group
- Inform University Police, Risk Management and Safety, San Marcos Fire Department or your building fire warden of any missing employees
- •Wait for the all-clear signal before reentering the building

Fire Safety Tips:

- 1. Know how to activate a fire alarm if you discover a fire.
- 2. Know emergency reporting numbers and where your closest exits and fire extinguishers are located.
- 3. Never prop open fire doors, and close all doors behind you when you exit due to an alarm activation.
- 4. Make sure hallways, corridors and stairwells remain clear of obstructions at all times.
- 5. Evacuate building immediately when an alarm sounds.
