The primary goal is to enable attendees to participate in interdisciplinary AI research groups and to incorporate AI in their subject-domain curricula. The workshop will emphasize the use of open-source material to tackle common pitfalls encountered in AI data analysis pipelines, including data sampling, feature selection, normalization, garbage-in-garbage-out phenomena, and overfitting. The workshop takes places at the Texas State University San Marcos campus.
