Service-Learning Excellence Program Service-Learning Research Award

This Award is intended to recognize and reward superior accomplishments, to provide models of excellence for fellow faculty, and to encourage all faculty to continue to perform, improve, and advance their service-learning research activity.

The award is made on an annual basis. All faculty including Clinical Faculty, Professors of Practice, Research faculty, Associate Deans, and Deans are eligible for these awards. Faculty may receive an Award more than once, but not more than once every three years.

The Service-Learning Research Award consists of a \$1000 stipend and a plaque.

Award Criteria: Awards are based on work conducted while appointed at Texas State University. In all award categories, a sustained record of achievement must be documented. In deliberations, the committee will place emphasis on accomplishments over the prior five years. Criteria include:

- 1. Sustained commitment/activity to service-learning excellence research;
- 2. Internal/external recognition;
- 3. Impact or significance of endeavors of the service-learning scholarly/activity.

A call for applications will be sent out to faculty by February 15th by the SLE Program Director. **Submission Requirements:**

Application portfolios will consist of (upload as single .pdf file):

- 1. Completed Application Narrative:
 - 1. Summary of scholarly/creative service-learning activities (250 words maximum).
 - 2. List of relevant Scholarly/Creative Activities (e.g., publications and grants).
 - 3. Summary (250 words maximum) of future service-learning research projects under review and/or in progress.
- 2. Narrative to elucidate accomplishments of the service-learning research. This may include a statement of personal goals or philosophy in award category and a statement that ties together activities (not to exceed 2 pages).
- 3. Internal/external invited letters/statements/testimonials to support accomplishments in award category (minimum of 3, not to exceed 4 letters).

Required format: 5 page maximum, single-spaced, 12-point Times Font, 1 inch margins **Submission Deadline:** Annual submission deadline is 11:59pm, May 1.

Application portfolios that do not conform to the above requirements will not be considered. **Submit application via email to:** <u>ServiceLearning@txstate.edu</u>, subject line: Research Award **Review Process:** By June 1, the SLE Program will review the applications, and make recommendations based on the criteria outlined above. The committee will forward their first, second, and third choices to the associate provost. The application forms and the names of all

university-level award nominees will accompany the ranked list of finalists.

By August 1, the SLE Program Director will announce the recipients of the award.

Reporting: Faculty non-submission of course metrics results in non-eligibility for SLE Grant and Award consideration for the following academic year.
