Increase Enrollment (San Marcos Campus, Round Rock Campus, and TXST Global)

Cabinet members discussed whether to cancel classes on September 16, 2024, the day of the presidential debate. A final decision will be made at the next Cabinet meeting.

Dr. Lessiter provided an update on the work of the Commission on the Run to 10-K Round Rock Campus. She reviewed the results of a student survey, academic program webpages, and a digital marketing campaign. She announced that 150 students have signed up for Discover Day, which will be held on April 6, 2024.

Improve Operations and Enhance Infrastructure

Mr. Algoe and Dr. Aswath led a discussion on the similarities and differences between LinkedIn Learning, TXST's current online learning platform for upskilling and reskilling, and Coursera.

Dr. Lloyd discussed Executive Order No. GA-44. TXST has until June 26, 2024, to comply with the new EO. We will await guidance from the TSUS Office of General Counsel.
