- 2 To be known as "A Simple Resolution Switching Senator
- 3 Manzanares' Senate Seat from the College of Liberal Arts to the
- 4 College of Applied Arts", which submits for confirmation of
- 5 altering Senator Manzanares's seat to his new college seat
- 6 within the Senate, and
- 7 WHEREAS: Current College of Liberal Arts Senator Alexis
- 8 Manzanares has undergone a change of major from political
- 9 science to criminal justice which places him in the College of
- 10 Applied Arts instead of the College of Liberal Arts, and
- 11 WHEREAS: According to Article IV, Section 2 of the Student
- 12 Government Constitution, "The Senate shall consist of 30
- 13 Senators representing the student body. 9 Senators should be at-
- 14 large spots who shall be elected by the entire student body and
- 15 18 Senator spots with each college have two undergraduate
- 16 representatives that will be elected by the students in the
- 17 college." Referring to Student Government's ability to alter the
- 18 current senator seats to affirm the composition of the Senate,
- **19** and
- 20 WHEREAS: According to Article IV, Section 5(D), line 1 of the
- 21 Student Government Constitution it states that "Undergraduate
- 22 senator vacancies shall be filled by the candidate receiving a
- 23 majority vote of The Senate at a regular or special meeting."
- 24 Therefore, the student senate has the power to fill the current
- 25 empty college seats by transitioning an active senator into
- 26 their respective college seat, and
- 27 BE IT RESOLVED: That Senator Alexis Manzanares relinquish his
- 28 current seat as a College of Liberal Arts Senator, and

- 29 BE IT RESOLVED: That Senator Alexis Manzanares fill the currently
- 30 vacant College of Applied Arts Senate Seat, and
- 31 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: This legislation be forwarded to the
- 32 Student Body President for further action.
