1 A Simple Resolution-

- 2 To be known as "A Simple Resolution Condemning the September $24^{\rm th}$
- 3 Hate Crime that occurred on campus" which submits for the
- 4 outward censure of violence and racial prejudice that has
- 5 affected our students and campus community.
- 6 WHEREAS: The Student Government of Texas State University, on
- 7 behalf of the student body of Texas State University, would like
- 8 to address the recent racial violence attack that occurred on
- 9 our university campus, and
- 10 WHEREAS: On Tuesday, September 24th, 2024, a black student
- 11 discovered their vehicle parked at Woods Street Parking Garage
- 12 was vandalized with a racial slur keyed onto their car, and
- 13 WHEREAS: On Thursday, October 3rd, 2024, the NAACP of Texas State
- 14 University put out a statement on social media addressing the
- 15 incident. In the statement, they had several requests of the
- 16 university to immediately condemn the hateful act, institute
- 17 change that allows the university to be better couriers for
- 18 social justice and further its commitment to combating racism.
- 19 They also asked that a review of security measures be conducted

- 20 to ensure the community has protections in place to prevent
- 21 future incidents of racial hate and crime, and
- 22 WHEREAS: Texas State University has a student population with
- 23 over 57% of our students identifying as people of color. With
- 24 such diversity, we should create an environment of inclusion and
- 25 respect, not one where hatred is tolerated. Every student
- 26 deserves to feel safe and valued, and it's important that as a
- 27 university, we work towards eradicating any form of
- 28 discrimination or hate, and
- 29 WHEREAS: As the legislative student body for Texas State, we are
- 30 committed to exploring avenues and legislation that promote
- 31 safety for all students and will continue to advocate for a safe
- 32 and diverse campus community, we stand with the NAACP and the
- 33 student that was victimized as there is no place for hatred,
- 34 violence, or prejudice on this campus, and
- 35 WHEREAS: Student Government echoes President Kelly Damphousse's
- 36 statement that, "Texas State University treats acts of racial
- 37 bias and hate with zero tolerance. Such acts, against even one
- 38 member of our Bobcat community, affect us all." This act of
- 39 violence is one that the entire community of Bobcats is affected
- 40 by, and we are obligated to call out racism, address violence,
- 41 and stand together when hatred attempts to tear down and
- 42 infiltrate our campus in such an egregious demonstration like
- 43 what occurred in the Wood Street Parking Garage on September
- 44 24^{th} , 2024, and
- 45 BE IT RESOLVED: The Student Government of Texas State University
- 46 formally supports and stands with the student that was
- 47 victimized and the NAACP of Texas State University, and

- 48 BE IT RESOLVED: The Student Government of Texas State University
- 49 formally condemns any form of racial bias, hatred, or prejudice
- 50 in our campus community, and
- 51 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: This legislation be forwarded to the
- 52 Student Body President for further action.
