- 2 To be known as "A Simple Resolution Confirming Samantha Regan to
- 3 the position of College of Liberal Arts Senator" which submits
- 4 for the confirmation of this nominee to fill a vacant Senate
- 5 seat.
- 6 WHEREAS: According to Article IV, Section 2 of the Student
- 7 Government Constitution, "The Senate shall consist of 30
- 8 Senators representing the student body. 9 Senators should be at-
- 9 large spots who shall be elected by the entire student body and
- 10 18 Senator spots with each college have two undergraduate
- 11 representatives that will be elected by the students in the
- 12 college. At least one voting Senate seat for a Graduate student
- 13 appointed by the Graduate House or elected. One Senator
- 14 appointed or elected to represent the Freshman class. One
- 15 Senator appointed or elected on to represent transfer students.
- 16 At least one Senator from the Round Rock campus appointed or
- 17 elected." Referring to Student Government's ability to appoint
- 18 an individual to take over the current vacant Senate seats to
- 19 affirm the composition of the Senate, and
- 20 WHEREAS: According to Article IV, Section 5(D), line 1 of the
- 21 Student Government Constitution it states that "Undergraduate
- 22 senator vacancies shall be filled by the candidate receiving a

- 23 majority vote of The Senate at a regular or special meeting."
- 24 Therefore, the Student Senate has the power to fill the current
- 25 empty Senate seats by taking a vote to confirm nominated
- 26 individuals for the remainder of the 60th legislative session,

- 28 BE IT RESOLVED: That Samantha Regan be confirmed to the position
