1 A Simple Resolution-

- 2 To be known as "A Simple Resolution Confirming Madison Koop to
- 3 the College of Education Senate Seat" which submits for the
- 4 confirmation of this nominee to fill a vacant Senate seat.
- 5 WHEREAS: According to Article IV, Section 2 of the Student
- 6 Government Constitution, "The Senate shall consist of 30
- 7 Senators representing the student body. 9 Senators should be at-
- 8 large spots who shall be elected by the entire student body and
- 9 18 Senator spots with each college have two undergraduate
- 10 representatives that will be elected by the students in the
- 11 college. At least one voting Senate seat for a Graduate student
- 12 appointed by the Graduate House or elected. One Senator
- 13 appointed or elected to represent the Freshman class. One
- 14 Senator appointed or elected on to represent transfer students.
- 15 At least one Senator from the Round Rock campus appointed or
- 16 elected." Referring to Student Government's ability to appoint
- 17 an individual to take over the current vacant Senate seats to
- 18 affirm the composition of the Senate, and
- 19 WHEREAS: According to Article IV, Section 5(D), line 1 of the
- 20 Student Government Constitution it states that "Undergraduate
- 21 senator vacancies shall be filled by the candidate receiving a
- 22 majority vote of The Senate at a regular or special meeting."

- 23 Therefore, the Student Senate has the power to fill the current
- 24 empty Senate seats by taking a vote to confirm nominated
- 25 individuals for the remainder of the 60th legislative session,
- **26** and
- 27 BE IT RESOLVED: That Madison Koop be confirmed to the College of
- 28 Education Senate Seat, and
- 29 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: This legislation be forwarded to the
- 30 Student Body President for further action.
