2. **Active Engagement Hours:** At least 25 hours must involve activities such as:
  - Small group instruction

  - Whole-class instruction
  - One-on-one student support

  - Supporting lead teacher instruction
  - Co-teaching
3. **Accredited School Setting:** These experiences must take place in a TEA or TEPSAC-accredited school, with actual students and content-certified teachers.
4. **Documentation and Reflection:** The candidate will document each experience and submit written reflections guided by our program.
